I-676 northbound lane and shoulder closures tonight as overhead sign replacement project begins in Camden Closures necessary to install barrier and implement traffic shift

(Trenton) – Lane closures are necessary overnight tonight on I-676 northbound as an overhead sign replacement project begins in Camden.

From 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, May 12 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, May 13, the left lane will be closed between just before Exit 5B to just after the 7th Street overpass to install construction barrier and set up a work zone in the left shoulder. After work is done in the left lane, the right lane will be closed in the same area overnight to install barrier and shift traffic to the left before the ramp to Exit 5B. The closures are required to set up work zones for daytime sign installation work, scheduled to begin Monday, May 15, and continue daily Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. for approximately four months.

The \$9.3 million state-funded project will replace sign structures on various routes in Bergen, Passaic, Morris, Mercer, Camden, Ocean, Union and Essex counties. The project is expected to be completed in fall 2023.
