Route 206 northbound daytime lane and shoulder closures as drainage improvements begin in Burlington County Closures necessary for manhole and inlet repairs

(Trenton) – Route 206 northbound is scheduled to have right lane and shoulder closures during the day this week just before Willow Grove Road/Old Indian Mill Road/CR 648 in Shamong to just before Vincetown-Buddtown Road/CR 642 in Southampton, Burlington County.

From 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. today, Monday, June 19, and tomorrow, Tuesday, June 20, the right lane on Route 206 northbound is scheduled to be closed from mile post 11.12, where Route 206 becomes two lanes in each direction, to mile post 11.5, where Route 206 northbound merges back into one lane. At least one lane will be maintained during construction.

In addition, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Wednesday, June 21, and continuing daily through Friday, June 23, at the same times, the right shoulder is scheduled to be closed on Route 206 northbound.

The closures are necessary to make manhole and inlet repairs. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays or plan an alternate route.

This work is part of the \$8.4 million state-funded maintenance contract that will improve drainage along Route 206 in various locations across Burlington, Camden, and Gloucester counties.
