## **Route 46 closed and detoured in both directions east of Ramseyburg Road following landslide in Knowlton, Warren County Traffic will be detoured using I-80**

**(Trenton)** – Route 46 is closed in both directions between Route 94/Portland-Columbia Toll Bridge and Manunka Chunk Road/Upper Serapta Road following a landslide east of CR 609/Ramseyburg Road in Knowlton, Warren County.

The roadway was closed at approximately 8:30 a.m. today, Sunday, July 16 following a landslide that resulted in soil, stones, and trees covering Route 46 east of CR 609/Ramseyburg Road in Knowlton. Work to remove the debris and repair any damage to the roadway is ongoing. Route 46 is expected reopen tonight. The following detour is in place:

### **Route 46 eastbound detour:**

- Traffic wishing to use Route 46 eastbound will be directed to use I-80 eastbound

### **Route 46 westbound detour:**

- Traffic on Route 46 westbound will be directed to turn right on CR 519/Hope Bridgeville Road
- Follow Hope Bridgeville through the town of Hope
- Take the ramp to I-80 westbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
