UPDATE

Route 46 remains closed and detoured in both directions east of Ramseyburg Road following landslide in Knowlton, Warren County Traffic will be detoured using I-80 until further notice

(Trenton) – Route 46 remains closed until further notice in both directions between Manunka Chunk Road/Upper Serapta Road and CR 519/Hope Bridgeville Road as debris cleanup continues following a landslide in Knowlton, Warren County.

The roadway was closed at approximately 8:30 a.m. today, Sunday, July 16 following a landslide that resulted in soil, stones, and trees covering approximately a half-mile of Route 46 between Manunka Chunk Road/Upper Serapta Road and CR 519/Hope Bridgeville Road in Knowlton. Work to remove the debris and trees, as well as to repair guiderail and any damage to the roadway is ongoing. Route 46 will remain closed until further notice. The following detour is in place:

Route 46 eastbound detour:

Traffic wishing to use Route 46 eastbound will be directed to use I-80 eastbound

Route 46 westbound detour:

- Traffic on Route 46 westbound will be directed to turn right on CR 519/Hope Bridgeville Road
- Follow Hope Bridgeville though the town of Hope
- Take the ramp to I-80 westbound
