## I-295 lane and shoulder closures needed for stormwater pipe replacement in Mansfield, Burlington County At least two lanes of traffic will be maintained during construction

**(Trenton)** – I-295 is scheduled to have daytime and overnight lane and shoulder closures in both directions beginning tomorrow and continuing for several weeks in Mansfield, Burlington County.

Beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, September 6 from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m., and again from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. Thursday, September 7, I-295 is scheduled to have single lane closures in both directions at milepost 53.4 near the I-95/NJ Turnpike overpass. The closures are required to replace a stormwater pipe underneath the roadway. Work will continue Mondays through Fridays at the same times for several weeks. At least two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction during construction.

In addition, the right and left shoulders will be closed for several weeks in both directions to create a work zone. Motorists are advised to slow, down, use caution, and expect delays.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
