Route 208 northbound lane closures tonight as culvert replacement project advances in Wycoff, Bergen County Closure necessary to implement traffic shift

(Trenton) – Route 208 northbound is scheduled to have lane closures tonight as a culvert replacement project advances in Wycoff, Bergen County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 15, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, September 16, lane closures are scheduled on a portion of Route 208 northbound between Cedar Hill Road and Russell to restripe the road to implement a traffic shift. The right lane is expected to be closed first, followed by the left lane. One lane will be maintained on Route 208 northbound overnight. By 6 a.m. Saturday, two lanes will be reopened with traffic shifted to the right. This traffic pattern is expected to remain in place for a few weeks for concrete work and conduit installation in the median.

The \$3.9 million federally funded project will replace the existing culverts on Route 208 northbound and southbound between mile posts 6.2 and 6.4. The project also includes guiderail replacement. Work is expected to be complete in summer 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
