Route 10 westbound right lane closed for emergency road work in Randolph, Morris County Left lane to be maintained during construction

(Trenton) – The right lane on Route 10 westbound is being closed for emergency road repairs in Randolph, Morris County. Motorists should expect congestion and delays, particularly through the evening rush hour.

Beginning at approximately 1 p.m. today, Thursday, January 2, the right lane on Route 10 westbound is scheduled to be closed for emergency road repairs between Dover-Chester Road and Arrowgate Drive in Randolph. The work is expected to be completed tomorrow, Friday, January 3, but an exact time remains to be determined. The left lane on Route 10 westbound will remain open during construction, and Route 10 eastbound will not be affected. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
