## I-295 northbound, I-76 eastbound Exit 1B to I-295 northbound, AND Route 42 northbound Exit 1B REOPENED in Bellmawr Overturned tanker cleanup and removal complete

**(Trenton)** – I-295 northbound, I-76 eastbound Exit 1B to I-295 northbound, and the Route 42 northbound Exit 1B to I-295 northbound have reopened in Bellmawr, Camden County.

The cleanup and removal of an overturned tanker on I-295 northbound was completed at approximately 9:45 p.m. tonight, Saturday, January 25, several hours earlier than expected. All lanes and ramps are reopened on I-295, I-76 and Route 42.

The tanker carrying butane overturned this afternoon on I-295 northbound before the covered roadway, where traffic from the I-76 eastbound Exit 1B ramp merges with I-295 northbound. This resulted in the closure of I-295 northbound and ramps from I-76 eastbound and Route 42 northbound while emergency personnel removed the butane, cleaned up the site and removed the tanker.
