I-78 eastbound lane closures Monday night for pavement repairs in Warren County Closures necessary for milling and paving

(Trenton) – I-78 eastbound is scheduled to have lane closures on Monday night for pavement repairs in Greenwich, Warren County.

Beginning at 7 p.m. Monday, April 14 until 6 a.m. Tuesday, April 15, one lane on I-78 eastbound is scheduled to be closed after the on-ramp from Route 173 in Greenwich for about one mile. At 9 p.m. a second lane is scheduled to be closed. The closures are necessary for milling and paving to repair a depression in the roadway. Work is expected to begin in the left lane and progress to the right to repave all three lanes. At least one lane will be maintained during construction. Motorists are advised to use caution and slow down when driving through the work zone.

Variable Message Signs will provide advance notification to motorists of traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
