Route 10 westbound lane closures tonight for priority gas main work in Randolph One lane maintained between South Salem Street and Millbrook Avenue

(Trenton) – The right two lanes on Route 10 westbound are scheduled to be closed tonight between South Salem Street and Millbrook Avenue for priority gas main work and resurfacing in Randolph, Morris County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Thursday, April 17 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, April 18, the right two lanes on Route 10 westbound are scheduled to be closed between South Salem Street and Millbrook Avenue. The closures are necessary for priority gas main work and resurfacing.

The left lane on Route 10 westbound and all ramps will remain open during construction. Route 10 eastbound will not be affected. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays when driving through the work zone.
