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Route 47 and Park Avenue Intersection to be closed and detoured Monday night in Vineland, Cumberland County Closures necessary to activate traffic signals and restripe the roadway

(Trenton) – The Route 47/North Delsea Drive and West Park Avenue/CR 540 Intersection is scheduled to be closed and detoured on Monday night as an intersection improvement project nears completion in Vineland, Cumberland County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. Monday, April 28 until 6 a.m. Tuesday, April 29, the Route 47/North Delsea Drive and West Park Avenue/CR 540 Intersection is scheduled to be closed and detoured. The closures are necessary to restripe the roadway and activate new traffic signals. Local access will be maintained for residents and businesses. The following detours will be in place:

Route 47/North Delsea Drive northbound Detour:

- Motorists on Route 47/North Delsea Drive northbound will be directed to turn right onto Landis Avenue
- Turn left onto North West Avenue northbound
- Turn left onto West Oak Road, back to Route 47/North Delsea Drive

Route 47/North Delsea Drive southbound Detour:

- Motorists on Route 47/North Delsea Drive southbound will be directed to turn left onto West Oak Road
- Turn right onto North West Avenue southbound
- Turn right onto Landis Avenue, back to Route 47/North Delsea Drive

West Park Avenue/CR 540 to Route 47/North Delsea Drive northbound Detour:

- Motorists on West Park Avenue/CR 540 wishing to access Route 47 northbound/North Delsea Drive will be directed to North West Avenue northbound
- Turn left onto West Oak Road, back to Route 47/North Delsea Drive

West Park Avenue/CR 540 to Route 47/North Delsea Drive southbound Detour:

- Motorists on West Park Avenue/CR 540 wishing to access Route 47 southbound/North Delsea Drive will be directed to North West Avenue southbound
- Turn right onto Landis Avenue, back to Route 47/North Delsea Drive

By 6 a.m. Tuesday, April 29, the intersection will reopen, and the new traffic signals will be operational. In addition, the left turn lanes on Route 47 in both directions will be shifted to accommodate a five-foot gore area, or a striped buffer zone, between the dedicated left turn lane and the through lane.

The work is part of a \$4.1 million project that will improve seven intersections in five towns -- Galloway, Gloucester, Pennsauken, Delran, and Vineland. In addition to the roadway reconfiguration and new traffic signals, other safety improvements that were made included new sidewalks with ADA-compliant curb ramps, pedestrian push buttons, countdown-style pedestrian signal heads, underground conduit, wire, junction boxes, and high visibility crosswalks.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
