I-287 and Route 17 to have temporary closures Saturday morning in Mahwah, Bergen County Closures necessary for Sheraton Crossroads demolition

(Trenton) – I-287 and Route 17 are scheduled to be closed temporarily tomorrow morning, Saturday, May 10, as a precaution when the Sheraton Crossroads hotel is scheduled to be demolished in Mahwah, Bergen County.

Beginning at approximately 7 a.m. until about 7:45 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, May 10, I-287 in both directions is scheduled to be closed temporarily between Exit 66 and the New York State line. Traffic will be diverted using Route 208. In addition, Route 17 is scheduled to be closed temporarily between Route 202 and I-287 at the same time. No parking will be allowed on the shoulders of either highway during the temporary closures.

The closures are necessary as a precaution during the demolition of the Sheraton Crossroads hotel, which is scheduled to take place at 7:30 a.m.. Both highways are expected to be closed for approximately 5 to 15 minutes after the demolition depending on how much dust is generated.
